What levels of reporting will be required if I'm successful?

The fund Coordinator will be responsible to Zero Waste Scotland for reporting and not the individual organisations. The Fund Coordinator will agree an approach with successful applicants for monitoring and evaluation. It is expected that reporting will be quarterly, and ongoing support will be available.

Do you think this would be available for community composting projects working with the hospitality sector?

We do not expect that food projects will meet the desired criteria.

How much detail on finance do I need to provide?

For the Stage 1 Application you are asked for an indication of how much you think the project budget would be for. If successful, at Stage 2 a detailed budget setting out staff costs, overheads, marketing, and any capital expenditure should be provided; all supported by a project plan.
